Professorship of Practical Theology II (m/f/d, 100%)

The E. Stanley Jones Endowed Chair of the Foundation for Evangelism (USA) at Reutlingen School of Theology (RTS) is to be filled as of October 1, 2025.

The position covers practical theology in teaching and research in the areas of theology of evangelism (research focus), fresh expressions of church, religious education, sociology of religion and diaconal studies. Part of the teaching is to be provided in the degree course "Social Work and Diaconia" and in the degree course "Christian Spirituality in the Context of Different Religions and Cultures".

Prerequisites for employment are: completed studies in theology; a doctorate in practical theology or a related subject area or achievements commensurate with a doctorate; at least five years of professional practice, at least three of which must be outside the academic sector; experience in teaching or training; preferably membership of the United Methodist Church.

In addition to teaching and research, participation in the administration and development of the school as well as active participation in its community life are expected. Residence in the Reutlingen area is desirable (an official residence is available).

Applications from severely disabled persons will be given preferential consideration if they are equally qualified. RTS aims to increase the proportion of women among its academic staff and therefore encourages qualified women to apply. Applications from people with a history of migration are expressly welcomed.
